

HOW TO:

MAKE OREO MOULDS

INGREDIENTS:

Oreos
White & Milk Chocolate
Flo Coat & Americolor Gel Paste
Lorann Flavour (optional)

EQUIPMENT:

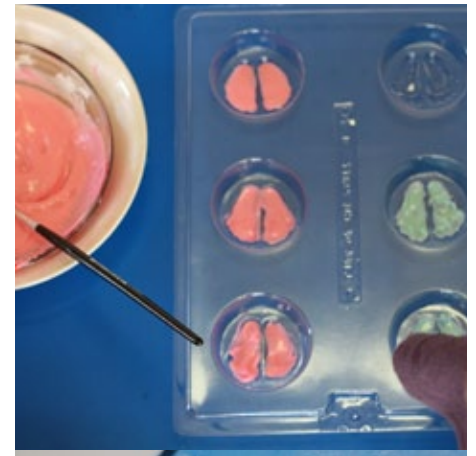
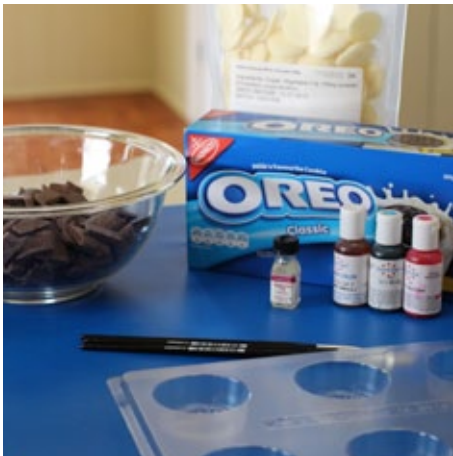
Oreo Mould
Paint Brush

1. Melt white chocolate over a double boiler and mix Flo-Coat with the gel paste colour.

2. Mix it into the white melted chocolate until your white chocolate has turned to your desired colour.

Carefully using your paint brush, paint the detail of the mould you wish to colour.
Let it set.

Tip: To prevent your chocolate in the bowl from setting to fast, stand it in a bowl of shallow hot water.



3. Half fill the mould with melted milk chocolate and then place the oreo into the melted chocolate allowing the chocolate to squeeze up the sides of the mould.

4. Cover the top of the oreo with a small amount of melted chocolate. Lightly tap on the counter to spread it and remove any airbubbles.

5. Allow to set in the fridge for at least 20 mins. Carefully turn out your completed chocolates. Have fun making different coloured ones!

Tip: Flavour your chocolate with Lorann flavours for a lovely surprise. Peppermint works well with Original oreos.
